<p>RESOLVED: (a) that the Board of Education of the Bemus Point Central School District, in the County of Chautauqua, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to expend the sum of \$15,841,689 during the 2019-2020 fiscal year, and to levy the necessary tax therefore.</p> <p align="center"> YES NO <input type="radio"/> <input type="radio"/> </p>	<p>RESOLVED: That the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Bemus Point Central School District (the "District") is hereby authorized to purchase school buses and similar vehicles for use in the transportation program of the District, at a maximum estimated cost of \$250,000, and that a tax is hereby voted (i) in an amount not to exceed \$250,000 to pay such cost, said tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as shall be determined by the Board, and in anticipation of said tax, bonds or other obligations (including, without limitation, obligations arising under leases, lease/purchase contracts or installment purchase contracts having a term of not more than five years) of the District are hereby authorized to be issued or entered into in accordance with applicable provisions of New York State law and (ii) in an additional amount sufficient to pay the interest on such bonds or the interest component payable under such other obligations, as the same becomes due and payable.</p> <p align="center"> YES NO <input type="radio"/> <input type="radio"/> </p>

<p>RESOLVED, that (a) the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Bemus Point Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District") is hereby authorized to undertake a "Bemus Elementary Improvements Project, 2019" (the "Project") consisting of the reconstruction, rehabilitation and renovation, in part, and the construction of improvements, additions and upgrades to, the District's Elementary School building and the facilities and site thereof to implement various health, safety, accessibility and Code compliance measures and various other measures that are included and generally described in (but not to be limited by) the Project Plan that was referred to in the public notice of the vote on this Proposition, and to expend therefor an amount not to exceed \$2,385,000; (b) the District is authorized to expend \$300,000 of available District funds toward the cost of the Project; (c) a tax is hereby voted in an amount not to exceed \$2,085,000 to finance the balance of the estimated maximum cost of the Project, such tax to be levied and collected in installments in such years and in such amounts as shall be determined by the Board; (d) in anticipation of such tax, obligations of the District are hereby authorized to be issued in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$2,085,000, and a tax is hereby voted to pay the interest on such obligations as the same shall become due and payable; and (e) New York State Building Aid funds expected to be received by the District are anticipated to offset a substantial part of such costs, and such funds, to the extent received, shall be applied to offset and reduce the amount of taxes herein authorized to be levied.</p> <p align="center"> YES NO <input type="radio"/> <input type="radio"/> </p>
