<p>Shall the following resolution be adopted? RESOLVED, that the budget for the Cassadaga Valley Central School District (the "District") for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020, as presented by the Board of Education of the District in the amount of \$24,047,251, is hereby approved and adopted and the required funds therefor are hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in the District to be levied and collected as required by law.</p> <p align="center"> YES NO <input type="radio"/> <input type="radio"/> </p>	<p>Shall the following resolution be adopted? RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Cassadaga Valley Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to purchase school buses and similar vehicles (and related equipment) for use in the transportation program of the District, at an estimated maximum cost of \$356,608, and to expend therefor, including amounts for preliminary costs incidental to such purchases, an aggregate sum not to exceed \$356,608; and be it further RESOLVED, that the sum of \$356,608, being the aforesaid estimated maximum cost, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and be it further RESOLVED, that in anticipation of such tax, bonds or other obligations (including, without limitation, obligations arising under leases, lease/purchase contracts or installment purchase contracts having a term of not more than five years) of the District shall be issued or entered into in accordance with applicable provisions of New York State law; and be it further RESOLVED, that New York State Transportation Aid funds expected to be received by the District are anticipated to offset a substantial part of such costs, and such funds, to the extent received, shall be applied to offset and reduce the amount of taxes herein authorized to be levied.</p> <p align="center"> YES NO <input type="radio"/> <input type="radio"/> </p>

Proposition No. 3 -
ESTABLISHMENT OF A TRANSPORTATION RESERVE FUND
(Vote YES or NO)

Shall the following resolution be adopted?
RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Cassadaga Valley Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to establish a new capital reserve fund (the "Fund") for the acquisition of and financing of various buses and similar vehicles (and related equipment) for use in the transportation program of the District, all pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law of the State of New York; that the Fund shall be known as the "Transportation Reserve Fund, 2019"; that the ultimate amount of the Fund shall be not greater than \$3,500,000 (plus interest earned thereon); that the probable term of the Fund shall be not longer than ten (10) years; and that the permissible sources from which the Board is authorized to appropriate monies to such Fund from time to time shall be (a) amounts applied thereto from budgetary appropriations of the District; (b) amounts from unappropriated fund balance of the District as directed by the Board; (c) to the extent specifically directed by the Board, State aid received as reimbursement for transportation-related expenditures by the District (whether or not such expenditures were financed in whole or in part from the Fund); (d) proceeds from the sale of real or personal property owned by the District, if permitted by law and if so directed by the Board; and (e) such other sources as the Board or the voters of the District may direct from time to time, as all may be permitted by law.
