**PROPOSITION NO. 1 -
BUDGET**
(Vote YES or NO)

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:
RESOLVED, that the budget for the Southwestern Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York, for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2020, as presented to the Board of Education in the amount of \$29,207,170 is hereby approved and adopted and the required funds therefor are hereby appropriated and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in said District to be levied and collected as required by law.

**PROPOSITION NO. 2 -
SCHOOL BUSES AND RELATED EQUIPMENT**
(Vote YES or NO)

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:
RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Southwestern Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District"), is hereby authorized to purchase school buses and related equipment for use in the transportation program of the District, including two (2) 66-passenger school buses (at a maximum estimated total cost of \$125,550 each), one (1) 60-passenger school bus (at a maximum estimated total cost of \$135,460), one (1) 30-passenger school bus (at a maximum estimated total cost of \$70,375), and one (1) 6-passenger vehicle (at a maximum estimated total cost of \$40,000), and to expend for all of such buses and related equipment an aggregate sum not to exceed the sum of \$496,935, being the aforesaid maximum estimated total cost, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law, and, in anticipation of such tax, bonds or other obligations (including, without limitation, obligations arising under leases, lease/purchase contracts or installment purchase contracts having a term of not more than five years) of the District shall be issued or entered into in accordance with applicable provisions of New York State law.

**PROPOSITION NO. 3 -
ESTABLISHMENT OF A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS RESERVE FUND**
(Vote YES or NO)

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:
RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Southwestern Central School District, Chautauqua County, New York (the "District") is hereby authorized to establish a capital improvements reserve fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law of the State of New York (the "Fund"); that the Fund shall be known as the "Capital Improvements Reserve Fund, 2019" of the District; that the Fund shall be established for the purpose of financing, in whole or in part, the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, expansion, renovation, alteration and improvement of buildings, facilities, sites and real property by the District, or the District's share of the cost of any capital improvements project undertaken by a Board of Cooperative Educational Services ("BOCES") of which the District is (or may become) a component district, including, in all cases, the acquisition of necessary furnishings, equipment, machinery and apparatus; that the ultimate amount of such Fund shall be not greater than \$5,000,000 (plus interest earned thereon); that the probable term of such Fund shall be not longer than ten (10) years; and that the permissible sources from which the Board is authorized to appropriate monies to such Fund from time to time shall be (a) unappropriated fund balance of the District, (b) State aid received as reimbursement for expenditures by the District in connection with District capital improvements (whether or not such improvements were financed in whole or in part from the Fund), (c) the proceeds from the sale of unneeded District real or personal property, and (d) such other sources as the Board or the voters of the District may direct from time to time.
